4. Ensure all FOS Presentations are scheduled by January 15th.
5. Ensure regular communication amongst team and help organize clean-up to 100%+ goal achievement by May 31st.
6. Attend the following Council Report Meetings:
  - 25% of Overall FOS Conference Call: February 27th
  - 50% of Overall FOS Meeting: March 31st
  - 75% of Overall FOS Conference Call: May 28th
  - 100% Victory Celebration: July 30th
