A NOMINEE MUST HAVE RENDERED NOTEWORTHY SERVICE TO YOUTH.

The nature and value of "noteworthy service to youth" may consist of a single plan or decisions that contributed vitally to the lives of large numbers of boys or it may have been given to a small group over an extended period of time.

A NOMINEE SHOULD HAVE CONTRIBUTED SOME SERVICE TO YOUTH OUTSIDE OF SCOUTING.

CONSIDERATION SHOULD BE GIVEN TO A NOMINEE'S POSITION AND THE CORRESPONDING OPPORTUNITY TO RENDER OUTSTANDING SERVICE BEYOND THE EXPECTATION OF DUTY.

A NOMINEE'S ATTITUDE TOWARD, AND COOPERATION WITH, THE DISTRICT AND COUNCIL IS TO BE TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION.

A NOMINEE MUST BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE DISTRICT DINNER IN JANUARY.
