This comprehensive basic training is the very best way for all Adult Leaders and Parents to be trained for their current and future Troop positions, to gain a thorough and basic understanding of how the Scouting Program works, to learn ways to apply this in their home units to help their Scouts run a successful troop program, and to obtain references and resources available for further knowledge.

<u>Class Prerequisites</u>: On the BSA National on-line training center (<u>https://my.scouting.org</u>), complete <u>Troop</u> <u>Committee Position Specific Training</u> (about 3 hours of online courses – see the attached page for highlighted courses), and <u>Scouts BSA Youth Protection Training</u> courses. Create a "My Scouting" account **using your BSA membership card number**, or log in with your e-mail address if you don't know your membership number (it can be filled in later when you have this information). Print out & bring the Certificates of Completion for each course (sometimes these won't print out until the next day).

- Registration is \$35 (Council fees/course materials and refreshments). Fees are payable when you check in at the first Indoor Session. Cash preferred but checks accepted (payable to GSLAC).
- New Scouts BSA Parents, Untrained Leaders, 2nd-Year Webelos Leaders, Scouts over 18...Please plan to attend and Preregister NOW!
- You will gain first-hand knowledge of how the Aims and Methods of Scouting work for your Scouts...and they will benefit greatly from your training!
- Participants are strongly encouraged to wear a Scout uniform. The uniform may be new or old, your own or borrowed. You do not need to purchase a uniform just for the Training sessions.
- Religious services will be held during the weekend campout.
- Participants will share the cost of food for their Patrol for Outdoor Weekend meals (\$12-\$15/person).
- Tent camping is involved for the Outdoor Weekend session. Participants will need to bring personal or borrowed camping gear. An equipment list will be provided at Indoor Session. Other participants and Staff Trainers may also loan equipment.
- Participants will schedule and attend a Patrol Meeting at in between Indoor and Outdoor sessions.
