The Scope of the Project Operation Pick Up Sticks!

- Organize scouters to do cemetery clean up of dead or fallen tree limbs throughout the Concordia Lutheran Cemetery property.
- This work will consist of youth, adult leaders and volunteers picking up these sticks and fallen tree limbs and dropping them off at designated gathering areas near the cemetery's roads within the cemetery property.
- The cleaned up piles will be picked up by adult volunteers and loaded onto trailers to be taken to the compost pile on the cemetery property.

The personal equipment you'll need Operation Pick Up Sticks!

- Work gloves.
- A Rake if you have one.
- Good pair of work boots.
- Protective clothing appropriate for cold or warm weather conditions.
- Wear Your Programs Activity Uniform.
- Back support brace if you will be lifting.

(Note: No-one is expected to lift heavy tree limbs. There will be chain saws assigned to trained adults only on site for cutting large limbs)
