- In the past year, we have recognized
   61,353 new Eagle Scouts, all of whom
   completed at least 21 merit badges, made
   significant contributions to their local communities
   and embody the Scout Oath and Law.
- The BSA's members and volunteers provided
  13 million hours of service to communities across the country last year.
- Scouts earned more than 1.7 million merit badges in 2019, introducing them to a spectrum of hobbies, careers, and life skills.
- In 2019, nearly 900,000 Scouts attended our day camps and summer camps across the country.
- Since 2017, the BSA has welcomed more than 160,000 girls into Cub Scouts and Scouts BSA.
- More than 40,000 participants from more than 150 countries attended the World Scout Jamboree.
- Throughout our history, 6,534 Scouts have received one of three national-level lifesaving awards, recognizing extraordinary heroism and skill in saving or attempting to save life.
